Implementation of the Project: 1st October 2021 to 30 April 2022

Summary:

With its 20-years of experience and professional background the Association for Women's Career Development in Hungary decided to address the impact of the pandemic on women, especially the impact on the labor market.

Therefore they we are pleased that together with the professional partners from the V4 countries, the Business & Professional Women CR z.s. from the Czech Republic, the Association of Business Women from the Slovak Republic and the Pedagogical University of Krakow from Poland, we have the opportunity to implement the "Women, Families, Careers – Effects of the Pandemic on Work/Life Balance in the Visegrad Countries" project between October 2021 and 30 April 2022 thanks to the support of the Visegrad Fund.

Within the framework of our Project, we will examine the impact of the pandemic on four special groups of women (mothers with children, women who are plan a family, women over 50, and rural women), in particular with relation to the labor market.
